

Weekly Classes

Class Description and Times:

Drum Effect's weekly classes provide tuition of traditional rhythms from West Africa on the djembe and dundun drums. Class teacher, Kate Susko, is a qualified teacher and accomplished djembe player. Kate has studied and performed with master West African drummers and undertook an intensive drumming and dance course in Ghana.

Drum Effect runs two classes: one for beginners and one for experienced drummers. In both classes students learn the calls, djembe and dundun parts, and breaks of traditional West African rhythms. The class for experienced drummers also focuses on solo phrases.

The Drum Effect courses advertised in this schedule are accredited by the ACT Teacher Quality Institute.

How to Enrol:

Continuing students – After you have indicated that you will be continuing, you need to pay the term fee by 20 September 2017 to secure your place.

When Drum Effect confirms that a place is available for you, you can then secure your place in the class by paying the term fee.
